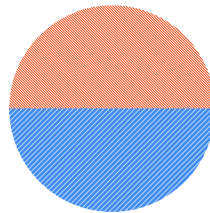

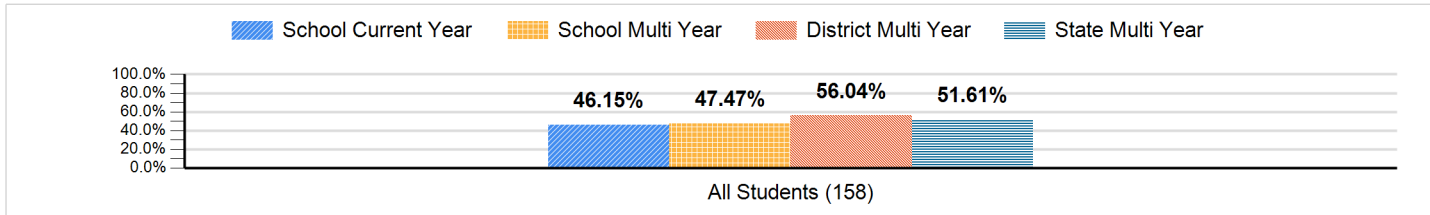
**Student Population**

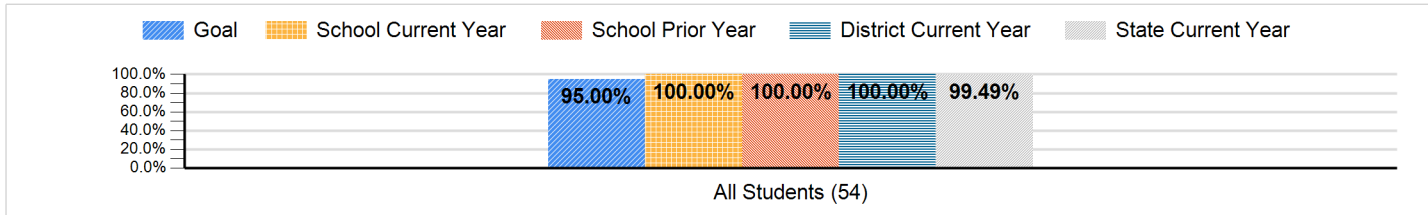

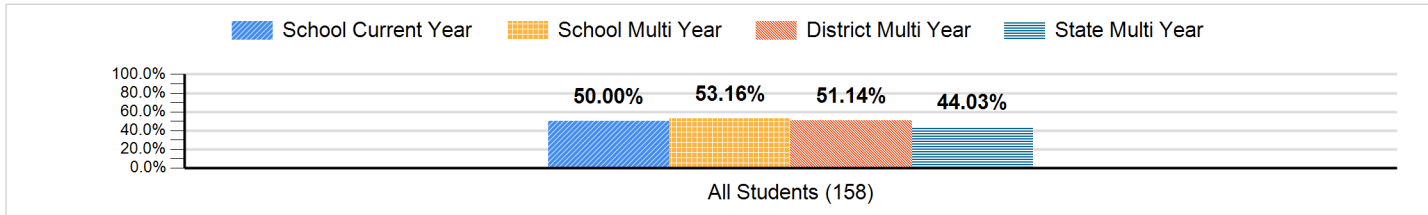

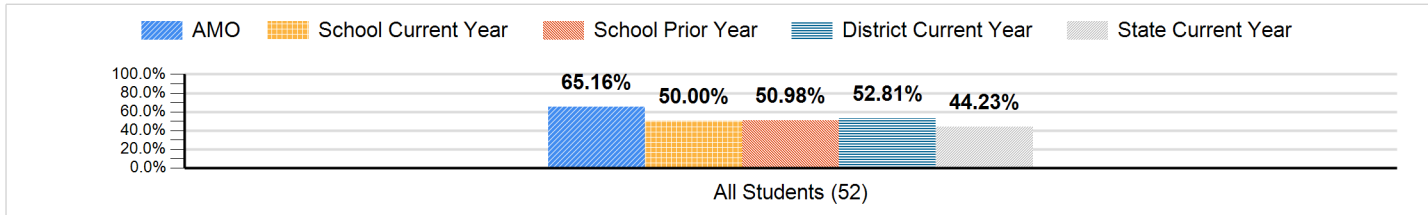

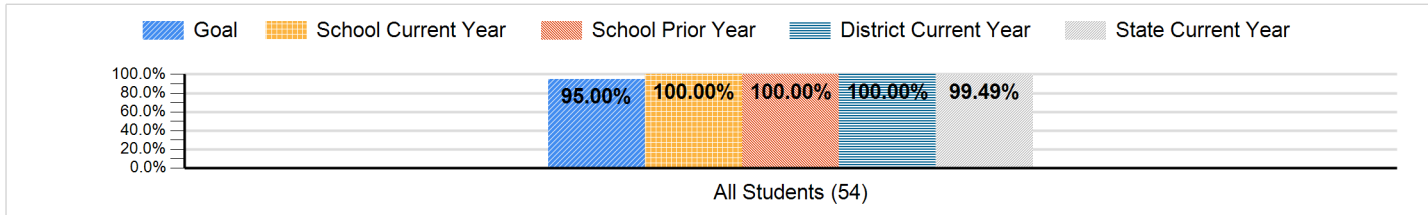

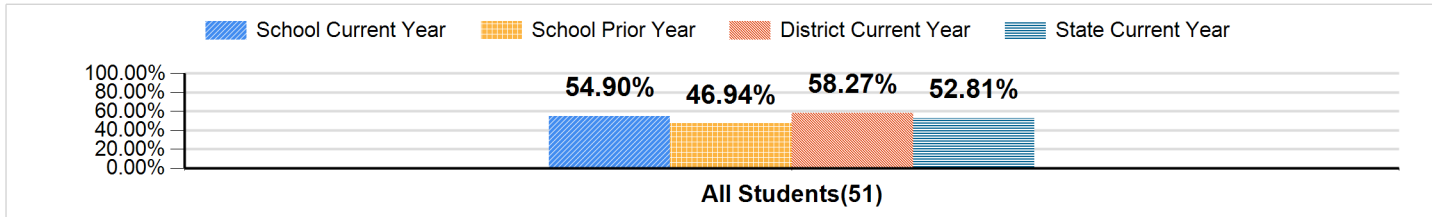

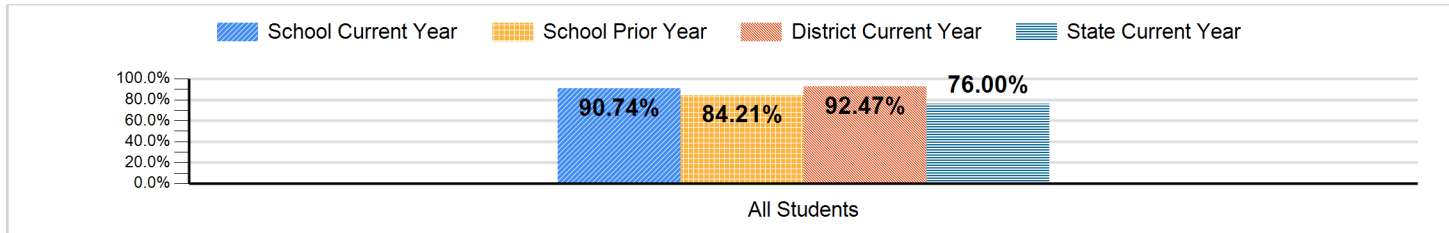
